
What is Read Write Inc.?



Teaching Sequence

Assessment

Students are assessed and grouped according to their phonic knowledge. Each student is then taught at the level of their phonic knowledge to ensure quick progress.



Teaching sounds

The 44 sounds and corresponding letters are introduced and taught systematically.





Levelled progression

Ongoing assessment means that any struggling students are picked up the moment they fall behind and if necessary given intensive one-to-one tutoring to catch up fast. Groups are adjusted regularly so all students make the best progress.



Teaching Words

Students learn to blend sounds to read words. Then they use short 'ditties' to practise early reading and writing before being taught more letter-sound correspondences.



Home-school link

For extra practice at home, teachers can send home the *My Speed Sounds Books*, black and white versions of the Storybooks and full-colour fiction and non-fiction Book Bag Books, to reinforce student's classroom learning. This ensures the books sent home are matched to the phonics students are practising in class. Home Learning Kits, with resources designed to be used at home, are also available to buy.



Developing reading and writing

Students read a series of levelled decodable texts, both fiction and non-fiction, and complete integrated writing activities including spelling, grammar, vocabulary and handwriting practice.



Vocabulary check

Tell your child the meaning of each word in the context of the book.

rubble	pieces of rock	rings of dust and rubble.




Reinforce classroom learning


Writing practice
