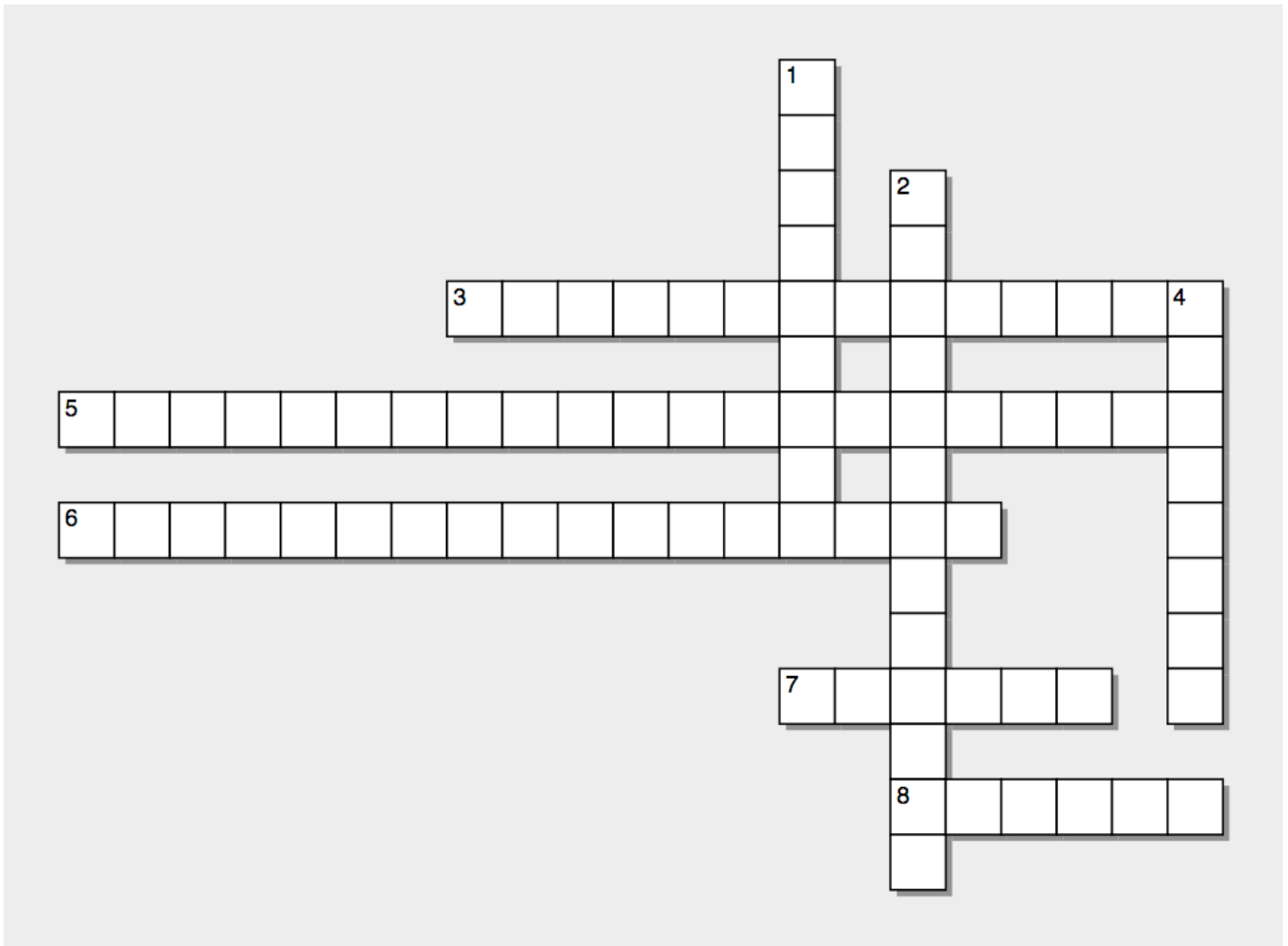


Chapter 4: Undue Influence, Unconscionable Conduct & Estoppel
