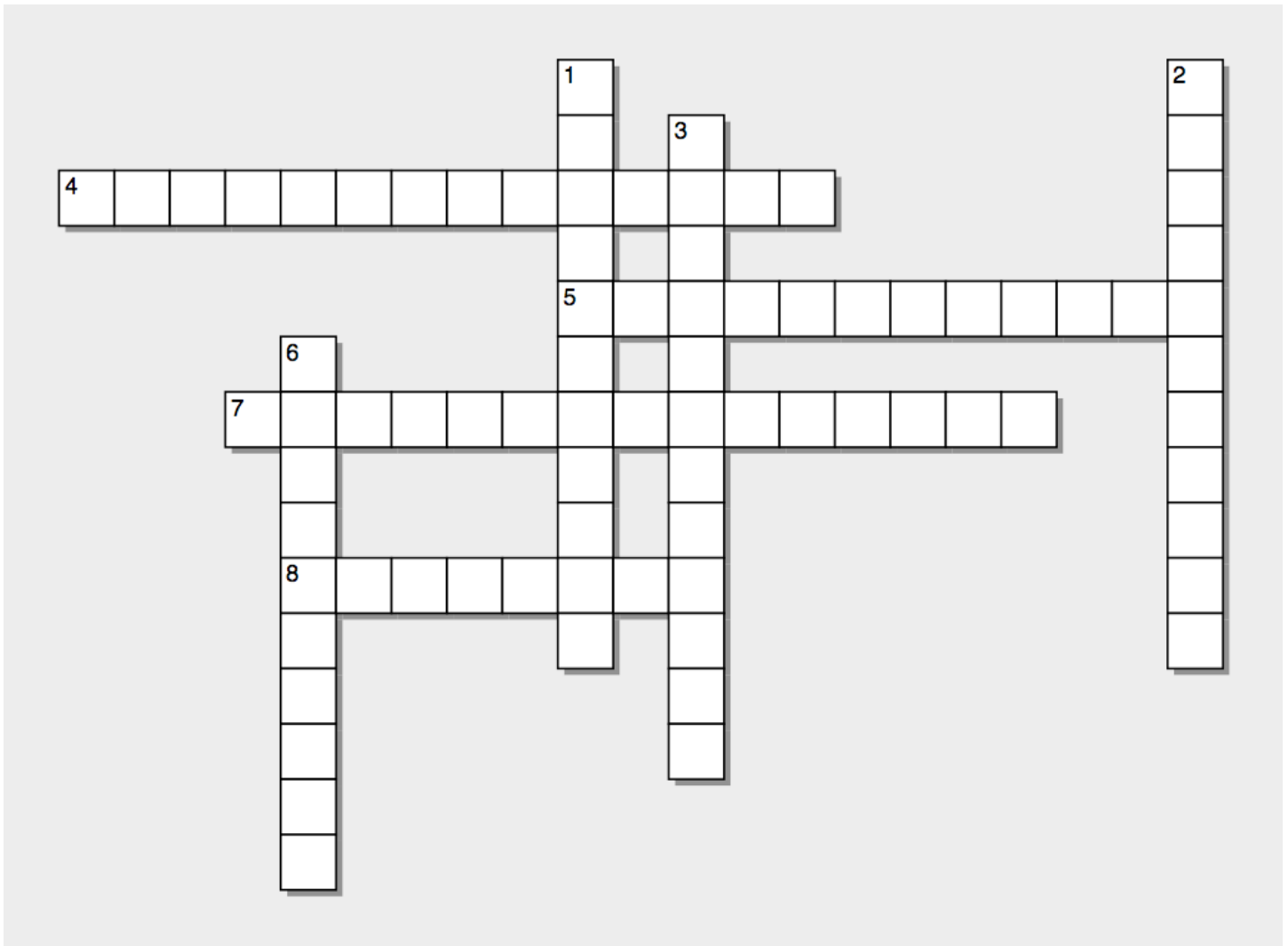


Chapter 5: Fiduciary Obligations & Confidential Information

2. This 1874 decision of the House of Lords concerned third parties being fiduciaries.
3. The Australian High Court decision in *United Dominion Corporation v Brian Ltd* (1985) was about this type of business vehicle/structure.
