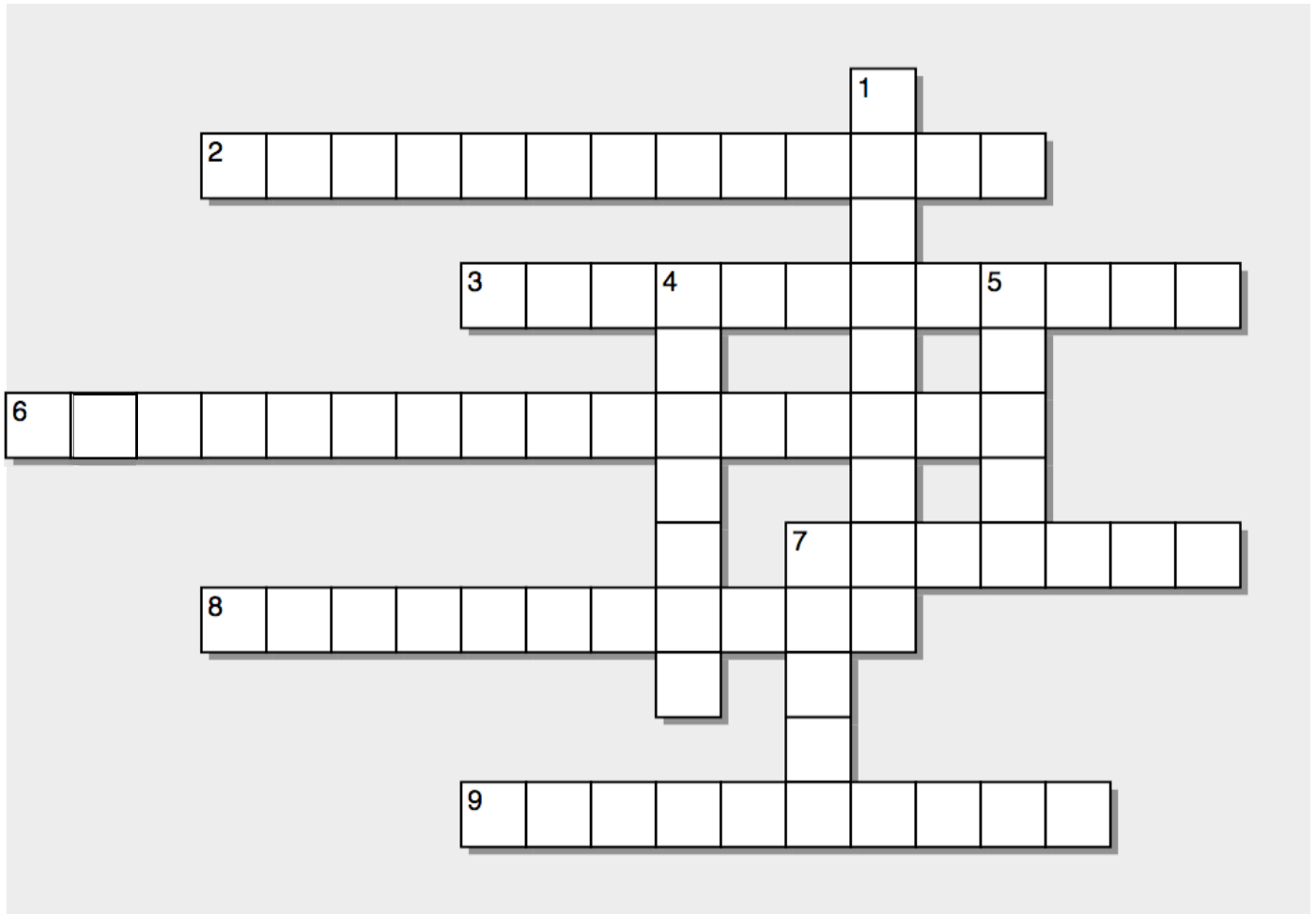


## Chapter 10: Trustees & Beneficiaries
