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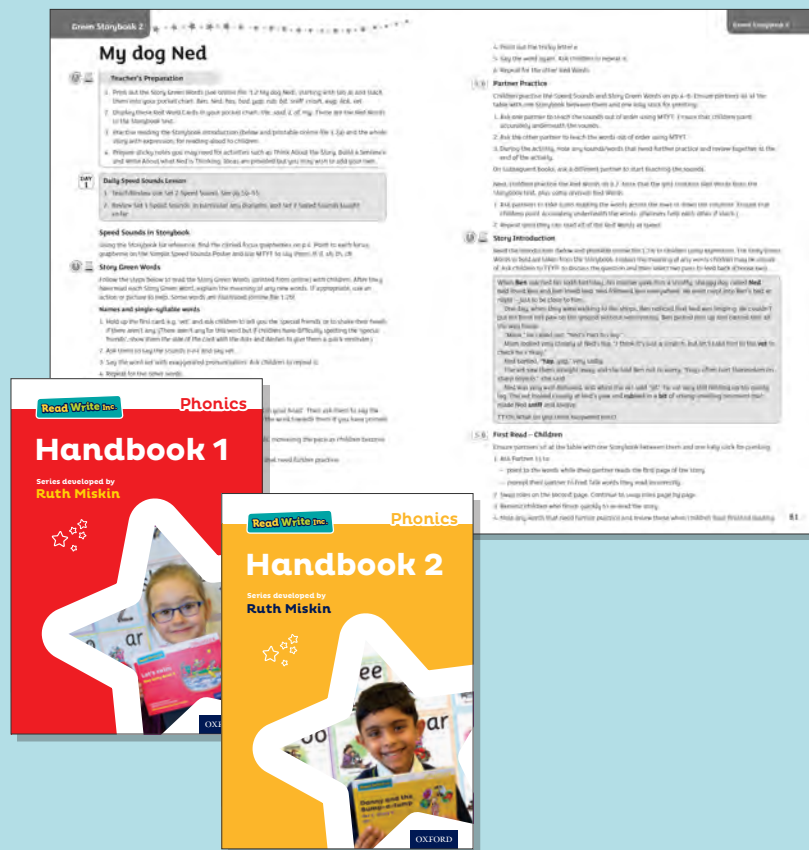
What do I need to teach *Read Write Inc.*?

Each handbook includes:

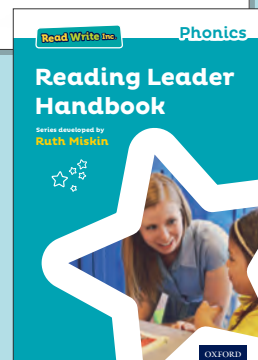
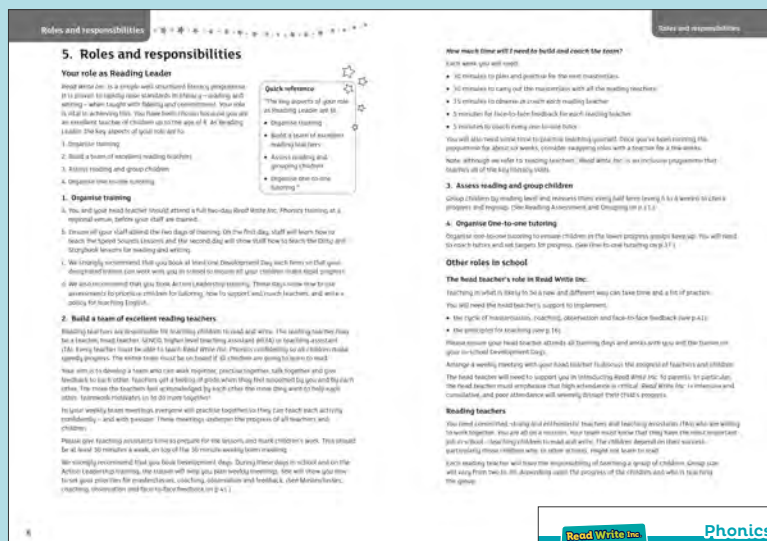
- day-by-day lesson plans that integrate Speed Sounds lessons, comprehension, vocabulary, grammar, handwriting and composition lessons

Reading Leader Handbook

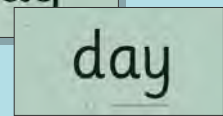
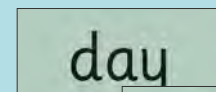
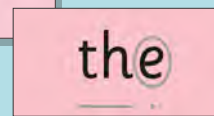
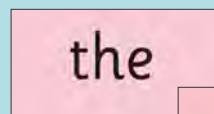
The handbook provides the Reading Leader with:

- one-to-one tutoring plans to ensure every child succeeds.



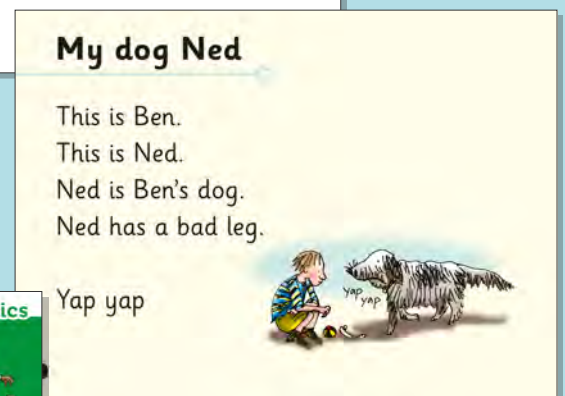
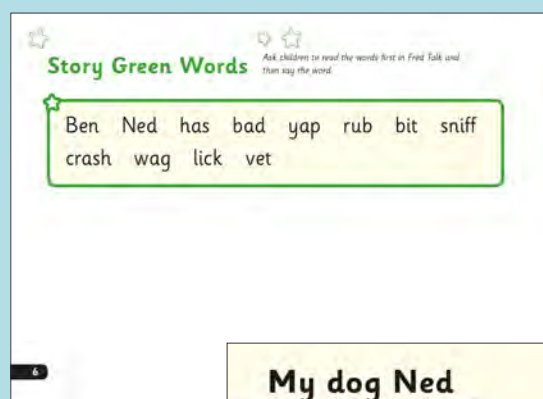
Teaching Sounds and Words

- Speed Sounds poster: support the teaching of sounds and graphemes and provide a quick review of letter-sound correspondences.
- Speed Sounds Cards introduce the 44 sounds and corresponding graphemes to enable children to decode words easily.
- Green and Red Word Cards help children gain fluency when reading the words independently.



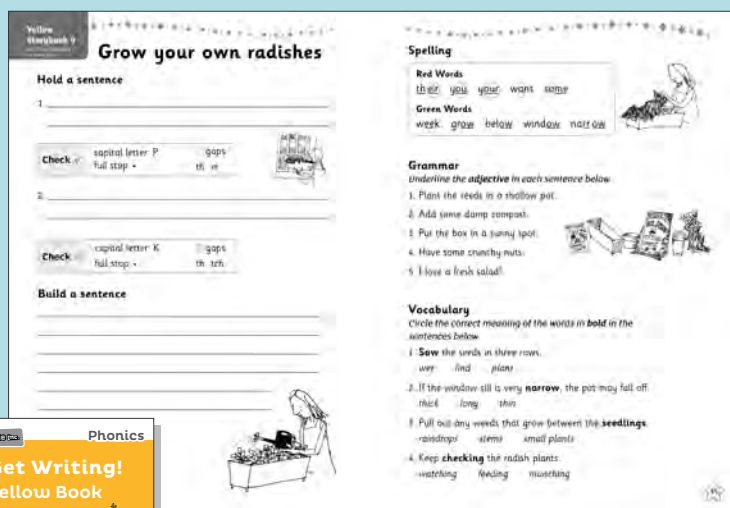
Storybooks: Fiction and Non-fiction

- There are eight levels of Storybooks from Red Ditty books to Grey Storybooks.
- They closely match to the students' increasing knowledge of phonics.
- Non-fiction is included at every level to give variety and depth.
- All the Storybooks allow for practice of known graphemes, and new graphemes are introduced in a controlled sequence.
- Black-and-white versions of the books are available for children to take home.



Get Writing!

- Guidance on teaching vocabulary and synonyms in dedicated vocabulary activities.
- A 6-step writing process, from rehearsing sentences to writing extended compositions.
- Activities are matched to the reading materials at every level of the program.
- Children practise transcribing and correcting sentences and are taught how to write fiction and non-fiction texts.
